In our area, there don't seem to be many Christmas light displays similar to it, so it really helps us retain attendance from our regulars and bring in some visitors at Christmastime, which is typically when attendance is lower.

One day while with the full-time soul-winners this month, we got off of the bus, and I saw an older woman sweeping the street outside her house. I approached her and asked if I could tell her how to go to heaven. She stopped what she was doing and gave me her full attention. After a couple of minutes, she accepted Christ as Savior!

Shortly after that, a young man, probably no older than 17, passed by me, and I offered him a tract. He told me his name was Jaime, and he was very interested in hearing the Gospel. I spent a few minutes talking with him, and despite some people passing by and distracting him briefly, he listened carefully and received Christ as savior as well!

It was a fantastic year overall, and we thank each and every one of you for your continued prayer and support invested in our ministry.
