Greetings all, we are thankful for your love care, and prayers,

Please pray for us as we have now been in Lusaka since Saturday evening. We greatly appreciated the Breaking of Bread meeting with our Brethren from Lusaka, yesterday, we went to a Fellowship meal afterwards and much enjoyed getting to know our Brethren more. We got bus tickets for Thursday today, we went to the Vision Care Opticians where we got a new pair of glasses for Samuel and a new? pair for me. Samuel's school recommends two pairs, the Eye doctor (who was originally from India) has been in Zambia eight years. His kids were here, but, sent back his children due to school cost being too expensive here.

Tomorrow is another Meeting night, their reading meeting, It's so encouraging to be amongst Saints in Lusaka. We will be spending three more nights at Baptist Guesthouse, full kitchen where we save money by preparing our own food. It also provides a large container of drinking water which saves us from buying bottled water. There is a large bed in the Master Bedroom and two beds where Samuel stays on the other side of the house. It is one of the more reasonable options for us. We will be paying for Samuel's School in the next days. Pray for the kwacha to the dollar, the dollar has lost its value last year in May the kwacha to the dollar was around 28 kwacha to the dollar. Now the Kwacha has improved, now, being 19.42 kwacha to the dollar. To help understand we pay 2,000 kwacha for rent each month. When it was 28 kwacha the rent was around \$70, at current rate \$103.

Pray for Samuel he has been a little under the weather, slight fever, congested, sore throat.

Pray for Sarah, her consultant is moving, Sarah is determining whether to ask for a refund and applying that money towards another option that uses Egoscue like exercises. Always appreciate your prayers that we heed the way the Lord leads us.

Thanks for your care for Sarah, Samuel, and I. We are in prayer about our need for continual and consistent Fellowship, Senanga at this time does not have a body of believers we can freely fellowship with, pray the Lord leads us in the way we should go.

Again, tomorrow, baby Ruth will get her formula, 1 can of formula 1 and 1 can of formula 2, if there is no reaction she will be solely on formula 2, she has reached six months old. Samuel when we gave him formula 2 he reacted to it and we had to keep him on formula 1.
