School for the local students is resuming Monday which is filling all the buses. We will spend a few days in Lusaka, need to get new prescription glasses for Samuel, he is very active at school and takes out his glasses about as fast as I do. I also may get a pair I am down to my last pair.

We are current with Samuel's Tuition, so thankful for The Lord's provision. The next term is still needing to be sponsored, but, Samuel's third term has been paid because we paid for two terms Samuel's first term at Sakeji. Our traveling expenses along with Guest House we trust that it will also be covered.

We are thankful for our support for Baby Ruth (Pict 1). Ruth is six months old, we have assisted since three months. The Lord has kept and protected us in Senanga during Christmas and New Years reports of people getting slashed by young men jumping out of trees and slashing them to steal from them. There was one known fatality. We take a taxi at 3:00 am to stay safe to go to the bus. We used to walk, but now it is common knowledge one doesn't want to be out past 6:00 pm (18 hours), after dark to stay safe. Sadly across the street from us at a police residence they sre selling alcohol which definitely adds to the noice on our street at night. So sad!!!! Pray for the continued testimony of Sarah, I, and Samuel. Christ is our all in all, pray for the Spirit of God to reach the lost in Senanga, Lusaka, and elsewhere. May those who belong to the Lord Jesus Christ hold fast in such the time we live in holding fast to the scriptures and pulling the lost from the flames as it says in Jude.
