

# THE BOSJES TO THAILAND


## January Update 2026

We praise the Lord for His guidance. When we started deputation almost three years ago, we thought we knew what the plan was when we arrived in Thailand. We thought we would be serving under another missionary initially and simply helping in the ministry here. Well, God had other plans. For the last five months, I have been the interim pastor of International Baptist Church of Hua Hin, and a couple of weeks ago, I officially became the pastor. We are honored to serve God in this role and are excited to see what other plans He has for the future. Heads up — it's probably not what we expect. :)



On January 10, Thailand celebrated Children's Day. Shops and businesses set up tables all over and give away free things to children. We set up a table and some carnival games in a public area and gave away 500 bags that contained a snack, a coloring book, a John and Romans, and a Gospel tract. Praise God that 500 children took home a copy of the Word of God!

The Lord gave me several special soul-winning opportunities this month. There is a family Katie Belle and I met during our Village Bible Clubs back in October of last year. They have been coming to church since then, but both of them were struggling with putting their faith in Christ. I met with them on multiple occasions and answered questions they had about God and the Bible. A few Sundays ago, Ploy, the wife, came to me after the service and said she was ready to receive Christ. She sweetly prayed and accepted Him as her Saviour! Please pray that her husband, PK, will soon be saved as well.



We took a last-minute trip to Bangkok to be with a missionary family who was having a medical emergency. Katie Belle stayed with them over the weekend, and I caught the bus back home. It was about a three-hour trip. I was seated next to a young man named William. I noticed he had the logo for a local soccer club on his shorts and asked him about it. We talked about sports for a while, and then I asked him about his soul. He told me he had been to church twice in his life, and both times he felt at peace. I told him he could live with that peace in his heart. He allowed me to share the Gospel with him, and about an hour later, he put his trust in Christ.



On the last day

of the month, we hosted a Youth Rally called "The Race," based on 1 Corinthians 9:24. Five other like-minded churches joined us, and there were a total of 65 teens in attendance. It was a wonderful time of games, competitions, food, fellowship, and preaching. Both my pastor friend Saint and I preached, and at the end of the service, almost 40 teens made decisions to serve God with their lives. These young people are the next generation of full-time laborers in the harvest here in Thailand, and it is exciting to see their hearts for the Lord.
