Back and Running in Thailand

Dear Pastors, Churches, Families and Friends,

Thankful for your prayers, as our safe arrival back into Thailand took place Saturday, January 24, 2026. We were back in our house by 5:00 that evening. Sunday morning, we were at International Baptist Church of Hua Hin, reuniting with the many who have been faithful in the Lord while we were away on our furlough. The spirit of the church was great, and the attendance was strong at 120. In the afternoon, Forest and I were right back into the soccer ministry with the young men, and I got to preach a message for them. It was a fantastic day and a blessed return. The following Wednesday, I preached for Pastor Pong at the International Baptist Church of Nong Phlap. This was also a very special time of fellowship and reconnection with our whole other church, full of faithful Christians whom we love and appreciate. God has given us much to be excited about, serving here with gladness. Bro. Matthew Bosje and Bro. Pong have done a marvelous job of pastoring the churches.

Friday morning after our men's prayer meeting, 4 of our young men came out soul winning with me, which was another very special reunion time. It was on that morning, January 30, 2026, at about 10:15, that Moss, a 21-year-old from Bangkok, heard the Gospel and chose to believe in Jesus for salvation. Thank God, there are souls ready and waiting to hear the truth in Thailand. Afterwards, we all loaded up the truck with different needs and spent the afternoon setting up for the Youth Rally, which took place from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. So much preparation and work was done together by staff and members of both churches, as the Hua Hin church hosted this large-scale Youth Rally. Sixty-five teenagers from 6 different churches attended. What a tremendous day it was, as most made important decisions and promises to God to improve their walk with and commitments to the Lord. Decision cards were filled out, and altars were full. Bro. Matthew Bosje and Bro. Saint Jomhong gave excellent, Spirit-filled messages. Ever since we left the USA on January 22, I had been battling much sickness. I was concerned about getting flagged or quarantined in the airports. However, we made it over, and God gave rapid windows of recovery afterwards. I think the joy of being here was healing in itself. After the Youth Rally, though, it took a large part of the week to fully regain my health. God is good.

Friday morning, February 6, 2026, Mr. A, age 43, who grew up going to a Catholic school in Thailand, finally understood the Gospel and wanted to be saved and trust in Jesus. We thank God for these divine opportunities and look forward to many more. Soul winning is always fuel for the fire in serving our great God. On Sunday, we spent the day at International Baptist Church of Nong Phlap, preaching both hours there, as Pastor Pong needed to travel to Northern Thailand. Sarah helped and taught in the Sunday school and Junior Church. Every week, one of the teen boys prepares and preaches an approved lesson to the Junior Church. They have really taken to the challenge and prepare well. Pong often has the teenagers sing music specials and involves them in all of the church activities in helpful ways. It is exciting to see young people who were once in the nursery now preaching and teaching God's Word!

Prayer Requests: There are many souls to be saved and trained to further future church growth in Thailand. Please pray as we labor. Please pray for future plans of travel within the country to connect more frequently with other like-minded pastors and missionaries throughout the area. It is our desire to prepare a Bible institute, which the young people of Thailand can one day attend. Please pray for both churches, as we continue to work, help, and facilitate in both. Please pray for more churches to be planted. Please pray for our visa plans to be successful and solid going forward. Thank you for all of your prayers concerning our furlough and return. Over 30,000 miles and 45 meetings later, we thank God for bringing us back. May the Lord keep blessing you where you are.
