

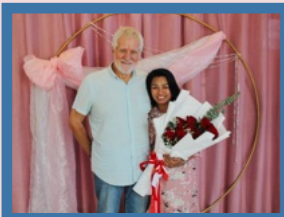
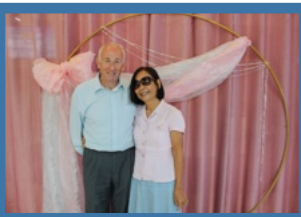
# THE BOSJES TO THAILAND

Horne's widow, run an orphanage and care for around sixty orphans. 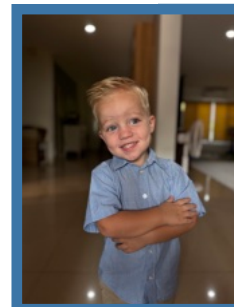
