Sarah and I went to the tent camp they have set up about a three to five minute walk from our home. Many have been displaced from their homes. This past Sunday I had Sydney as my interpreter. We talked to some that had been in the tent city for a week and some who had been there a month. We were told it may be a couple months before the water recedes, where the people will then return to their homes and rebuild. Though the flooding due to much rain this past rainy season has been much more intense this year. Generally every rainy season there are many accustomed to moving from the flood plains to rebuild their simple homes when the rains go. What brought it to our attention was a helicopter checking out the river a little over a week ago. Pray for these people both for their need for Christ and the physical challenges that would exist, as they are now, a large tent community. The Government is working on putting a bore hole for water there. They have many different community service people assisting on a daily basis. Many people have brought their dogs all seeming to get along.
