The Lord has truly blessed our recent ministry efforts. Harvest Baptist Church, the work we've been helping with in northeastern Nigeria, just celebrated its first anniversary, with 120 people in attendance! While they still meet in the pastor's living room, they are already busy constructing their first building. Please continue to pray for this pastor and growing congregation. We also had the joy of visiting and preaching for another church, where Emily has assisted the pastor's wife through a major health crisis. Seeing that family healthy and serving Christ was a profound highlight.

Please also pray, as our church's co-pastor of ten years is moving back to his home area to start a church. This is a big transition for our church. Please pray that members in our church will step up in responsibilities, and please pray for us as we work to teach and train our members towards greater maturity and leadership.

One of the hurdles in serving our Nigerian people here is their knowing that we are going to stay. So, we have been praying for and looking for a house with property to buy here in Nigeria. This signals to our people that we are committed and staying. Plus, with our current landlord having quadrupled our rent, the need for a permanent home has become clear.

God has led us to a property at an excellent price. It is very near our current location and still in a safe area. Because of years of saving and living simply, we are able to purchase the house and land debt-free this May. However, we are getting it at such a great price because the house requires significant repairs and renovations. At the current exchange rate, we estimate US\$40,000 is needed for these major repairs.

I only mention this because so many of you have asked how you can specifically help our family. This project is our "next big step" in establishing longevity in serving here. If you feel led to give toward these repairs, it would be a tremendous blessing as we turn this house into a home for our family and a hub for our ministry to continue serving in Nigeria for years to come.
