Thank you for your faithful prayers for our family and the work of the Lord here in Thailand. The last two months have been full on, and we have so many blessings to share. Our visa situation is almost completely sorted, and we praise the Lord for providing the way and the means to keep us in His service here in Thailand. The Lord truly goes before us to prepare us a place and to show us by what way we should go. The believers here are strong and growing in faith and service. The young people have caught a fire for the Lord. Many souls are coming to know Christ, with new soul winners leading their first person to a saving knowledge of our Lord Jesus.

Toward the end of February, we were able to attend a conference 16 hours away at the ministry started by the late Missionary Rick Horn back in 1991. We rejoiced to see what God can do with faithful decades of committed service to Him. Over 20 Thai pastors attended the conference. While this was exciting to see, it stirred our hearts for the need for many, many more pastors in this country. So many millions have no one to show them the way of salvation.

The first week of March, we were able to go back to the very first church we helped to plant almost 18 years ago and teach and preach. What a joy it was to see so many faces, both old and new, who are living for Jesus. We also got to visit one of their church plants, preaching to a wonderful group of loving Christians. We thank God for the work being done by these ministries in Bangkok and beyond.

Throughout March, the Hua Hin church had soul-winning training each Thursday. Pastor Matt Bosje did a great job teaching each week on how to share the Gospel with the lost. Kem, a teenager from the Nong Phlap church, decided to attend after seeing some of his friends attend the training. He was so excited to learn how to share the Gospel. The very next day, he went out with the Friday morning men and teens and was able to lead a 10-year-old boy to the Lord. The next week, the Lord gave him another opportunity to talk to a boy who also was ready to ask Jesus to save him. Kem told us it was like God just gave him the words to say. Our daughter Harmony was also able to lead a lady named Duean to the Lord the same night. We thank the Lord for her burden for souls. Harmony is passing out tracts everywhere she goes and prays for the people she hands them to. Sarah and Joom led two ladies to the Lord. Min had a very rough past and had heard a little bit about Jesus. When she understood that Jesus knew her past and wanted her anyway, she burst into tears. Her salvation was sweet, and she immediately told her friend Noot to come and hear the Gospel—Noot was also saved that night.

On Friday, March 27, we took a full van to visit the church members who drive an hour to come to church. It was an amazing day, as we would visit one, and they would climb into the van and take us to visit a friend of theirs. Our 11-passenger van had 16 adults squished in at one point. Four of the friends who were visited were given the Gospel and accepted Christ as their Saviour, with another wanting to learn more about Jesus. Pray that we can soon have what is needed to start a church for these faithful believers in their own city.

The last Sunday in March, there was a teen activity, with 27 teens from both churches in attendance. God is working in the hearts of the next generation here in Thailand. Our family has personally led 41 souls to Christ since our last prayer letter, and the average Sunday church attendances have been 97 and 133.
