## University Ministry

After many months of seeking for approval to hold church services at a nearby university where we have been going soul winning for several years, we received final approval in February! On Sunday morning, March 1, we held our first service! We had 12 people in attendance. In the first 6 weeks of having services, we have had several students come to visit our fellowship group. We are taking the students through our church's discipleship curriculum in our Sunday school hour. We continue to go soul winning at the university on Saturdays, and each week, we have been able to lead students to Christ. There are over 30,000 students at this university. Please pray that God will use us to reach more of these students for Christ. Pray that God will bless our efforts to disciple the students and that many of the students will become fruit-bearing disciples of Christ.



## Converts / Disciples

The Lord allowed me to lead 13 souls to believe on Him through personal soul winning in February and March. Last August, I led a university student named Nhyira to Christ. On February 28, I went to follow up on him and met his roommate Arthur. Arthur was very open to the Gospel and gladly trusted Christ as his Saviour! Arthur and Nhyira have both been attending our Sunday services. Arthur contacted me on a Thursday one week and asked me if he could join us for soul winning. He came soul winning with us on Saturday and was able to be with me as I led another student to Christ. Please pray for Arthur to grow and to become a dedicated soul winner.

Last April, I led a university student named Ernest to Christ. On March 21, I was doing visitation and ran into him again. He introduced me to his brother Richmond, who is staying in his dorm room. Richmond was very open to the Gospel and trusted Christ as his Saviour that day. Both Ernest and Richmond came to our Sunday service and have expressed an interest in being a part of our fellowship group. Please pray for these two young men to be established in the faith and to grow.

A few months ago, a man named Raymond started attending my Sunday school class. I asked him if I could meet him on a weekly basis to go through our church's discipleship curriculum with him, and he readily agreed. He has a lot of zeal and was able to work through the curriculum much faster than the average person. I asked him if we could go through our church's soul-winner training program, and he said he was happy to do so. We have done one workbook together, and I took him soul winning with me last Wednesday. I was able to preach the Gospel to three young men, and two of them trusted Christ as their Saviour. Raymond was so excited. He told me afterwards that he had recorded the whole conversation on his phone, and he was going to go home and listen to it so that he could learn more. Please pray for Raymond to become an effective soul winner.

Please pray for us, as we will be conducting our annual SMITE (Student Missions Institute for Training in Evangelism) youth camp April 13–17. Pray that the campers will surrender their lives to serve Christ. Pray that many children will be saved as a result of the Bible Clubs conducted by the campers throughout the week.
