Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

We thank God for answered prayer! We often pray for God to send forth more laborers into His harvest. We specifically pray for God to bring the right students to our Bible college. We praise God for bringing to our day college in the first four months of this year **SEVEN new Bible college students**. Let me briefly introduce you to them: **Alexander** is the man reached because of our Bible Club ministry, whom I wrote about in January. He is faithful to our Sunday school class, joins us for soul winning on Saturdays, and has brought his two children to our church. **Emmanuel** is from Sierra Leone. Emmanuel had been staying in the area. He was reached with the Gospel by our fellow missionary, Charles Osgood, and he started attending our church several months ago. **Simeon, Stephen, and Ernest** just joined us from Liberia. God providentially brought them into contact with our Bible college. **Angela** stays in the local area but does not attend our church. She is attending our college for the sole purpose of being trained to win souls for Christ. And then **Raymond** was won to Christ by Pastor Speer several years ago and now has moved back to the area. He desires to do God's will for his life.

Emmanuel, Simeon, Stephen, and Ernest are dormitory students. They are in what we call our "Faithful Men" program. Another young man named **Emmanuel** is from our daughter church in Kunsu; he had taken some classes in our college before, but earlier this year, he also joined our "Faithful Men" program. These men stay on our church property full-time and are much like junior staff members. They do various jobs for the church while at the same time attending college classes, doing book reports, improving their English skills, going soul winning, and participating in outreach ministries. Please pray for our students to grow in grace and for God to continue leading believers to serve Him.

Bible Club Training: A couple of weeks ago, Joy and Faith had the privilege to participate in our church's annual SMITE Camp. This is like a miniature Youth Conference for the purpose of training young people to conduct Bible Clubs. All week they learned about conducting Bible Clubs in the morning, and then in the afternoons, they put their training into practice. This was Joy's fourth and final year and Faith's first. Joy was a Bible Club leader for the week. Faith was one of her workers, along with Elizabeth and Vanessa from our church and Blessing, the daughter of one of our daughter-church pastors. They had a total of 38 different children attend, and 19 of them trusted Christ. Also, Joy encouraged her convert and friend – another girl named Blessing – to attend the camp. The day after the camp, Blessing used what she learned in the camp and won 5 children to Christ! Also, our son Ben attended Miss Larae Hoff's Bible Club near our house and was able to win one of the children at the club to Christ!

Please pray for Maria; she will be teaching a class for ladies in our Bible institute on Thursday evenings in May and June.
