Dear Praying Friends and Supporting Churches,

Please view our new web page! If you are interested in helping with missionary projects to help advance God's kingdom and lay up treasures in Heaven, then this web page – www.fbcikumasi.com/projects – is for you!

As we plant more churches here in West Africa, there are more needs to be met. Often, pastors or donors will ask how they can help further meet the needs of the ministry work.

For this reason, my staff and I have dedicated a portion of our website for posting projects in need of funding. Each project is an opportunity for a church or an individual to partner with our church or one of our daughter churches to meet a need and help reach more souls for our Lord Jesus Christ. We launched this “project page” (www.fbcikumasi.com/projects) several months ago, and the Lord has already used it to provide several donors with the chance to make a significant difference in church and ministry here in West Africa.

Examples of Funded Projects:

- We raised money to purchase a “trike” to help the Fundamental Baptist Church of Mampong start a bus route AND to transport soul winners to towns around Mampong that desperately need the Gospel. Additional funds were given to help a second ministry purchase such a vehicle.
- One donor contributed enough money to keep Pastor Michael Naab on the air over a radio station near his church in Kunsu. People are being saved and added to the Fundamental Baptist Church of Kunsu because of the radio ministry. A man named Mr. Adusei joined this church due to the radio ministry, and his wife recently visited as well.
- Donors also helped us with a yearly need our church has – SMITE camp. SMITE stands for “Student Missionary Institute for Training in Evangelism.” During our annual SMITE camp, many young people are taught in the mornings on how to conduct Bible Clubs. Then they actually conduct Bible Clubs in the afternoons. The evenings are reserved to stir the hearts of the teens and young adults to serve the Lord. At this year’s SMITE camp, held a couple of weeks ago, we had 115 campers from 12 different churches. A total of 27 Bible Clubs were held, and over 1,500 children attended, with over 500 professing faith in Jesus Christ. We praise God for this!
- Land was purchased for a daughter church in Liberia, which is pastored by our graduate, Sylvester Gonquoi.
