Once again, it is such a blessing to write to you all and tell you about what God is doing here on the mission field of Guam! March and April were busy months, and it has been amazing to see what God has been doing!

March was a fun month. We started off by having Bible club for the kids in the village of Yona. We had 20 kids in attendance—praise the Lord! During March, we also started the first spring program of Bible Baptist Church. The Lord blessed the program greatly as we had a total of 7 first-time visitors, 3 saved, and 1 baptism. God sure is good! We also had two of our church men get together and volunteer to put in our new church roadside, praise the Lord for the work they put into it, the sign looks amazing!

April started off amazingly as we celebrated Easter Sunday. This was also the end of our spring campaign, the first one many of our church people had ever been a part of. We had 54 people in attendance for Easter Sunday, including 4 first-time visitors. After the service, I met with one of the visitors, Sauson, and we talked for quite a while. I got to share the Gospel with him, and he accepted Christ as his Savior!

To top the month of April off, Guam was partially hit by Super Typhoon Sinlaku. My family and I want to thank everyone who prayed for our safety, along with the safety of the island. Thankfully, the damage on Guam was minimal. The main issue was the island losing power for five days. You don't realize how much you love air conditioning until it's gone!

Please continue to pray for the ministry here. We have shifted our focus in phase two of our renovation project to work on our church van. It needs quite a bit of repair work done. Once we are finished with the van, we plan to continue working on the church by investing in another split A/C unit for the auditorium. I want to thank everyone who prayed for my back problems, there for a bit it was looking like I would have to come back to the states for surgery but the Lord healed my back, it still has some problems but thankfully I don't have to come back to the states early.
