April 2026 Update

April was an amazing month! We had over 100 people in church every Sunday, with many souls saved and several very special occasions that took place throughout the month. One of those was Bible English Camp. We hosted a 3-day camp at the church and invited children in the community to come and learn English. Each day we taught English, played games, and preached to them. There were almost 70 kids who came over the course of the 3 days, and at least 9 accepted Christ as their Saviour. Miss Shari House did a great job organizing this effort, and it was a personal blessing to see so many of our church members jump in and help.



Easter Sunday was a very special day. We gave every person who came a small gift and had an Easter egg hunt for the children after the service. There were 119 in church, with almost 20 first-time visitors.



May was one of the girls who was saved during the week of Bible English Camp. Her grandmother Maam had seen a sign advertising our camp and brought her each day. They came to church the following Sunday as well, but Grandma Maam dropped May off and then sat outside during the service. I caught her afterwards and asked why she hadn't come inside. She said she thought poor people like her weren't allowed. I asked if I could visit her at her home, and a few days later, some of our young men and I went by to see them. We met Dtai, her blind daughter, and gave them both the Gospel. Together, they sweetly trusted Christ. The following Sunday, all three of them came to church and were baptized—three generations at once! Since then, they have come faithfully for every service. Last week, Dtai told me she has never felt so loved and welcomed anywhere in her whole life.



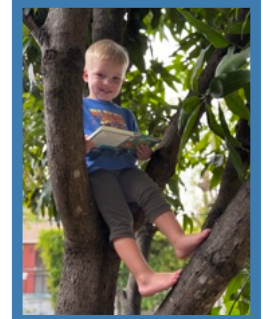
