We communicated qith Samuel's Namesake a relative with Samuel's name and he asked if we were coming we at first said no, we wnt the Father to not fill pressured to give Social Welfare the blessing of adopting Samuel, which we must be given to adopt Samuel. We found out this am from Samuel's Uncle the more desirable thing would nbe to greet the Father and family. Pray for the Lord's undertaking. We began not having the funds to consider this Journey, yet through brothers and sisters throughout the body of Christ made it exceedingly abundantly possible. We are seven hours ahead of Iowa. The bank opened 4:00 pm Senanga time. We were told this am that a bus would be leaving at 20 hours (8:00pm) We found through automated banking money had been put in yet it was not accessible. Through dear brothers and sisters who communicated they would put in. We then heard the money was in, the bus I contacted said they would not be going tonight at 8:00pm. Our friend Sydney checked for other buses and found a bus Ryan who normally we didn't consider due to some rough rides we chose to aim for it. The challenge was we only had 30 minutes to make it to the bus. I called Ba Kenny he drove Sydney to our place and picked us. I needed money from ATM , Zambia celebrated Freedom Day yesterday while the U. S. celebrated Memorial Day. Ong story short both ATM's for the one bnk in town had no money. Money was there in kur account, but, not in the machine. I went bck to the station saying I tried multiple times different amounts with no success. I ran to the bus station. Samuel stood there , I said I couldn't get anything. Sydney our friend ran off and gave us needed funds, we we 260 kwacha short. Between Sydney and Ba kenny our friends who we call our Zambia family we managed to get on the bus. We fortunately can go to any talktime booths to send the money back into our friends account once we get to Lusaka. The trip has started out in amazement , thus far everyone has been quite respectful, music mainly with a quote Christian flair. It is at a level I can tolerate with my ear plugs in. We just had a sto around 10 pm where we all had to wash our hands under a container of running water. Then back on the bus. Do need our Brothers and Sisters continued prayers, God Bless!!!!
