In my last prayer letter, I asked you to pray for a couple in our church whose newborn son was fighting for his life. Our church rallied around the Garganians who are graduates of our college and on staff. On Sunday, April 19, the Lord saw fit to bring little Jabez to Himself to join his sister who had passed away less than two years previously. The Lord has strengthened this couple, who have been an example of those who continue to trust and serve their Saviour, even when their hearts are broken. We praise the Lord that all the expenses of the hospitalization and funeral were met. Thank you for praying for them.

With the DeMovilles being on furlough in the States, life was busier than usual here. We have had to use the new expansion in our auditorium to accommodate our growing attendance. We enjoyed a great Resurrection Sunday as we celebrated Jesus' victory over death and the grave. Our people continue to be faithful soul winners, as so far this year, we have seen 3,834 saved, 384 public professions of faith, and 168 baptized.

Our annual Vacation Bible School was held April 27–May 1. This year, we conducted 29 separate meetings daily in neighborhoods all over the area and ended with a rally at our church on Friday. We were able to draw 677 people to VBS, with over 290 saved and 319 attending the rally. It is amazing how God can use His people when they work together to reach the lost!

The DeMovilles returned home during VBS, and it was good having everyone back in their places. We worked again to ready ourselves for our annual Youth Rally being held May 19–21. Much effort was expended in transforming the auditorium to welcome 184 delegates from several churches. The theme this year was "Sober" (I Peter 5:8), as for 3 days and 2 nights teens and college-aged young adults listened to 10 powerful messages and 2 split sessions from the KJB. God worked in many hearts, and many important decisions were made.

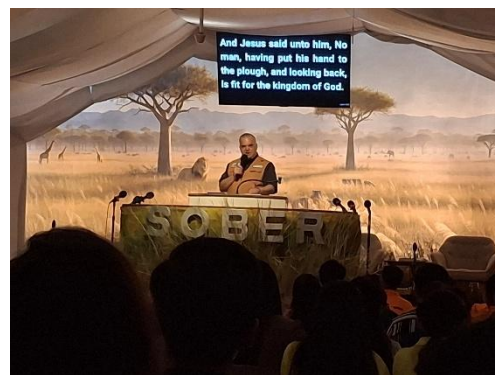

We look forward to his "coming back home" and helping us in reaching Filipinos for Christ.
