I am truly grateful that the RMMO has a role in planting churches around the world and witnesses how Men of God water these churches and areas with the Gospel of Christ. We are incredibly blessed to see, month after month, how the Lord brings increase to His work!

With the many works we support, we realize how many Christians struggle around the world. Many Christians in other nations do not even have the freedom to serve God. One of those countries is Iran. Please pray they can eventually become a free nation where the Gospel can be spread without fear of retribution. The same applies to many other countries that persecute those who have been saved by the blood of Jesus. This is why we support the Refuge in Nigeria. It's difficult to comprehend the level of fear that some Christians endure—not just the fear of being jailed, but even the fear of mutilation or death.

Pastor Elvis Vamboei, whom we support in the Congo, held a service in the Kuilu Village. He had 23 people put their trust in Christ. The Congo can be a very dangerous place to live, not just from the government, but also from rebel groups looking to kill those who do not follow Muslim beliefs. Pastor Vamboei asks that you please pray for this Village and these people who decided to follow the Lord.

I was honored to visit one of the new church plants we support in Arkadelphia, Arkansas. I preached the Sunday I was there and was thrilled to see the Mayor of Arkadelphia, his wife, and niece walk down the aisle and ask the Lord to save them. Pastor Daniel Miller is doing a great job, and I look forward to continuing to receive reports from him. (picture below)

We were excited to learn about the work that Brother Andrew Chafa is doing to provide radio towers for various ministries. He has three upcoming projects across three different continents, but he recently completed a significant project by successfully installing a 10,000-watt transmitter for the Caribbean Radio Lighthouse in Antigua, West Indies. It is truly a blessing to help provide a means for thousands to hear the Gospel over the airwaves.

Through God's goodness, we have been able to provide for different needs that exceed our usual support. This month, we were fortunate enough to help purchase a van for Pastor Liam Skogen in Minnesota. Additionally, we sent \$2,700 to the Baptist Heritage Children & Aged Harbour in Nigeria to cover the third term school fees for the children. (See pictures below.) It is truly a blessing to meet the needs of our church plants in so many ways. God is so good!

The RMMO is dedicated to planting new churches both in America and around the world. We are incredibly grateful for all the prayers and support we receive. Without this support, we would not have been able to aid in the start of over 240 church plants, support two orphanages (one of which we built), provide assistance to a girls' home, and support two foreign colleges.
