We have expressed a need for continued prayers at about Amano Christian School. Samuel was so confident

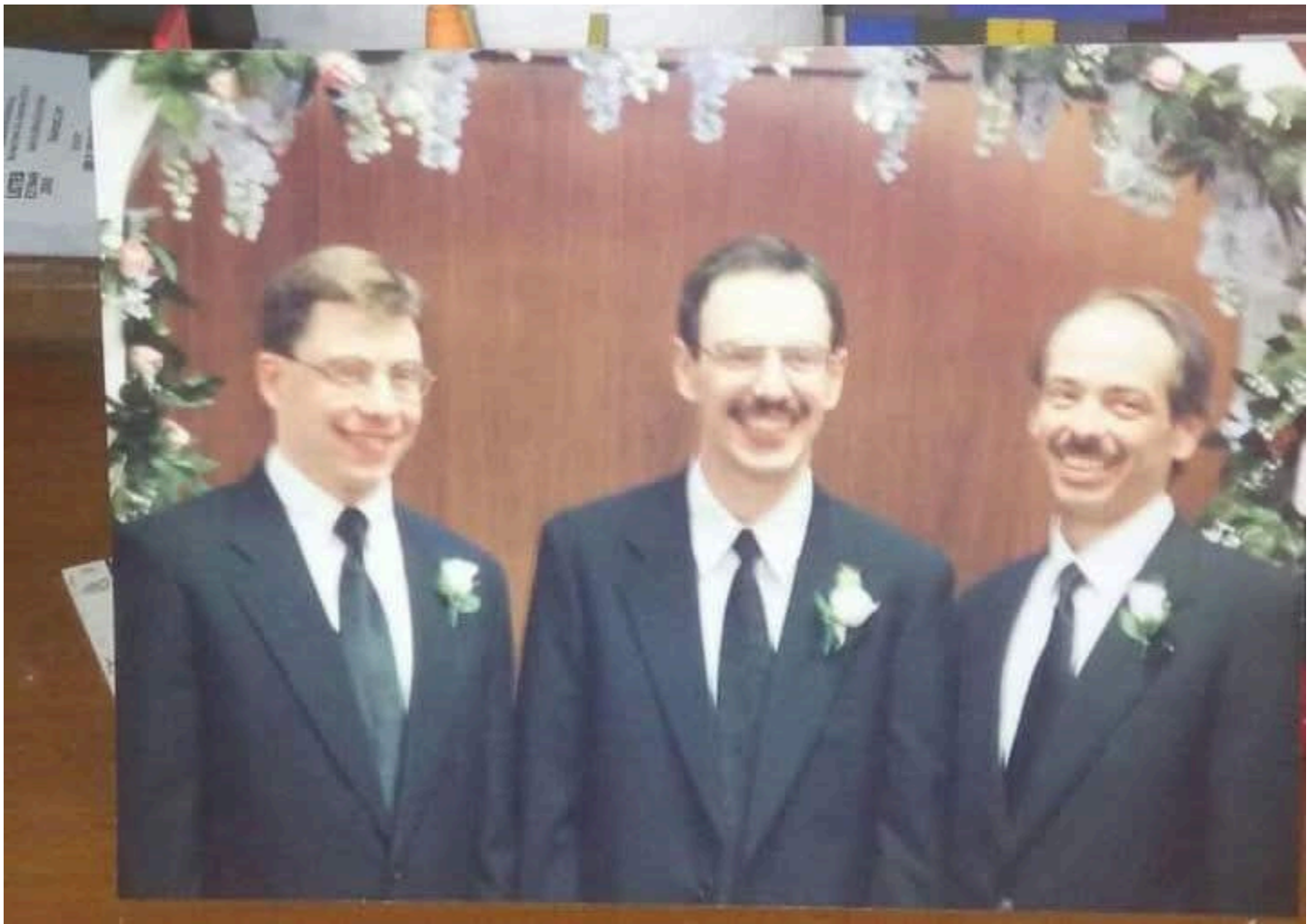
